


Art and Craft Village

VISIT TO PALLAVARAM FRIDAY MARKET

The second year students of Department of Management Studies visited Pallavaram Friday Market on 14th October 2022 which is located at Arumalai Chavadi, Pallavaram, Chennai, Tamilnadu. It is popularly known as Pallavaram Sandhai and has it's origin in 1800. The market is open only on Fridays, and is known locally as the Friday Market. The market extends to a length of over 2Km and there are about 250 plus stalls available in this market, in which the agro based stalls contribute the most. Many second hand electrical products are also sold and it is obvious that many local people come there to buy the products. Most of the sellers are from nearby districts. They come to this market every Friday to sell their products. This is one of the most diverse markets, students have ever seen. It starts with furniture, second hand electrical products, metal vessels, old artifacts; clothing stalls etc., and ends with pets, ornamental plants, spices, vegetables, dried fishes, fruits etc. The heart of this market is it's vendors because they still sell the products after the pandemic to save the culture and character of Friday market. Inspite of the chaotic crowd in the market, people are eager to buy some stuff.



The best thing about this market is that it is well organized. It is the nature of Indians that they are much organized and co-operative in chaotic situations. The place where the vendors set their stalls by pitching tarpaulin sheets is determined by the time they reach the market before Friday morning. It's just first come first serve basis. The vendors compete in the market with hundreds of vendors who were trying to get the best spot to set the stall and sell their products. The vendors will be at the both sides of market road at the beginning of it which is filled with furniture items and after the half path the vendors will cover both sides of the road and at the center of the road, people can barely walk in between the stalls and there will be no space for vehicles. It will take an hour to visit the whole market. The visit to the started gave an insight on marketing to the students.



The students visited the rural business which is coir fibre farm located in Atchikadu, Marakkanam, Tamilnadu. Coir pith or Cocopeat or dust is a biomass material obtained during the extraction of coir fiber through coconut husk and hence a byproduct of the coir industry. The owner of this business is Mr.Velmurugan who is a successful entrepreneur for many years and doing his business judiciously and ethically.

The availability of raw material coir fibre is abundant in India and it provides employment opportunities for rural area population.

REPORT ON INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO NIKITA CONTAINERS (P) LTD

Date: 24.03,2023



INTRODUCTION: Nikita Containers Pvt. Ltd is located in lyyankuttipalayam, Kurumbapet, Puducherry-09.

They are manufacturing tin containers which are used in many industries like food and beverage, cosmetics and pharmaceuticals. They provide tin containers for many leading companies.

Raw materials:

They get the raw materials (tin sheets) from their branch in Chennai and are printed with the required information, design of the products' containers, date of production, name of the product, total quantity of the sheet and their net weight. After the raw materials are checked they are send for production. The raw materials are bought with 18% GST.

Production Process:

All the printed tin sheets are cut down to the required sizes. They pass through the process of shaping the sheets into containers. They are shaped by hydraulic press. The center part, the top part and the bottom part are made separately. After all the parts are fixed, they are sealed.

- They use solar energy of 40%, the rest 60% electric supply.
- The machines are maintained weekly on Sundays.
- Employees total strength: 135 on roll, Peak Period 200
- Working hours: 8 hours shift, 2 hours over time. The employees are given 15-20 min breaks.

Sales and Products:

Food and beverage industry: 80% of their products are for food and beverage industry.

They provide containers for the following products:

- ✓ Cookies, Sweets, Coffee, Pepper, Nuts, Tea, Chocolates, Liquor, Lip Balm, Talcum Powder etc.
- They manufacture three kinds of containers:
- * Primary containers- direct contact with the material/product.
- Secondary containers- prevented from direct contact with the material with help of paper.
- * Tertiary containers- containers will be placed in a separate box and will be sealed for shipping.

Impact of Covid 19: Covid 19 didn't impact them much because it is mainly producing the tin containers for food and pharma products which had high demand during that period.

Sales and Shipment: They started their business for producing containers for Yardley Talcum powder initially and now they produce many varieties of containers which are shipped to countries like UK, Dubai etc. They earned a turn-over of 68 crores in 2021.

Conclusion: The industrial visit to NIKITA Containers was very informative and educative. Students learned about the kinds of tins, the process of making the tin sheets into a final product. The company has all the safety measures like fire alarm, assembling point etc.



INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO RAJAGANAPATHY PAPER MILLS


On 17th June 2022 BBA II students were sent for an industrial visit to Rajaganapathy paper mills at Vadamangalam, Tamil Nadu. The company was established in 16 December 1987. After a brief interaction with the Managing Director of the company Mrs. Balakrishnan Shakuntala, the students were divided into four teams for better interaction and easy understanding for the working of the plant. The working of the plant was done by Mr. Udayakumar who is currently employed there. A flow chart representing the working of the machinery is given below: -



Raw materials required for this plant is mainly of three types 1.Carton boxes, 2.Colour records, 3.Plastic film roll. Raw material arrive from suppliers of Coimbatore and Karnataka. The raw materials are also sourced from local small suppliers. The prices of the raw materials vary from Rs.17/Kg to Rs.25/Kg.

The raw materials are crushed and mixed with 10KL of water to turn it into a pulp. Which the goes through screening and gets collected 4 tanks with an individual capacity of 2KL each. Here the cationic sizing takes place. Then the pulp is sent on a conveyor belt for drying which is in turn monoglazed and rolled into a finished product. The PH is set >5. Each finished roll weighs around 750Kg. The plant at full capacity can produce 14 – 15 tonnes of finished product. The manpower is supplied by S.R agency.

After the explanation of the working of the plant the students were served with hot tea and potato fritters before the boarding the bus.

INTRODUCTION: Nikita Containers Pvt. Ltd is located in lyyankuttipalayam, Kurumbapet, Puducherry-09.
They are manufacturing tin containers which are used in many industries like food and beverage, cosmetics and pharmaceuticals. They provide tin containers for many leading companies.

Raw materials:

They get the raw materials (tin sheets) from their branch in Chennai and are printed with the required information, design of the products' containers, date of production, name of the product, total quantity of the peet and their net weight. After the raw materials are checked they are send for production. The raw materials are bought with 18% GST.

Production Process:

All the printed tin sheets are cut down to the required sizes. They pass through the process of shaping the sheets into containers. They are shaped by hydraulic press. The center part, the top part and the bottom part are made separately. After all the parts are fixed, they are sealed.

- They use solar energy of 40%, the rest 60% electric supply.
- The machines are maintained weekly on Sundays.
- Employees total strength: 135 on roll, Peak Period 200
- Working hours: 8 hours shift, 2 hours over time. The employees are given 15-20 min breaks.

Sales and Products:

Food and beverage industry: 80% of their products are for food and beverage industry.

They provide containers for the following products:

- ✓ Cookies, Sweets, Coffee, Pepper, Nuts, Tea, Chocolates , Liquor, Lip Balm, Talcum Powder etc.
- They manufacture three kinds of containers:
- * Primary containers- direct contact with the material/product.
- * Secondary containers- prevented from direct contact with the material with help of paper.
- * Tertiary containers- containers will be placed in a separate box and will be sealed for shipping.

Sales and Shipment: They started their business for producing containers for Yardley Talcum powder initially and now they produce many varieties of containers which are shipped to countries like UK, Dubai etc. They earned a turn-over of 68 crores in 2021.

Conclusion: The industrial visit to NIKITA Containers was very informative and educative. Students learned about the kinds of tins, the process of making the tin sheets into a final product. The company has all the safety measures like fire alarm, assembling point etc.
